Let the light in: Swap out old, dim light bulbs for bright, daylight LEDs and wash the windows.

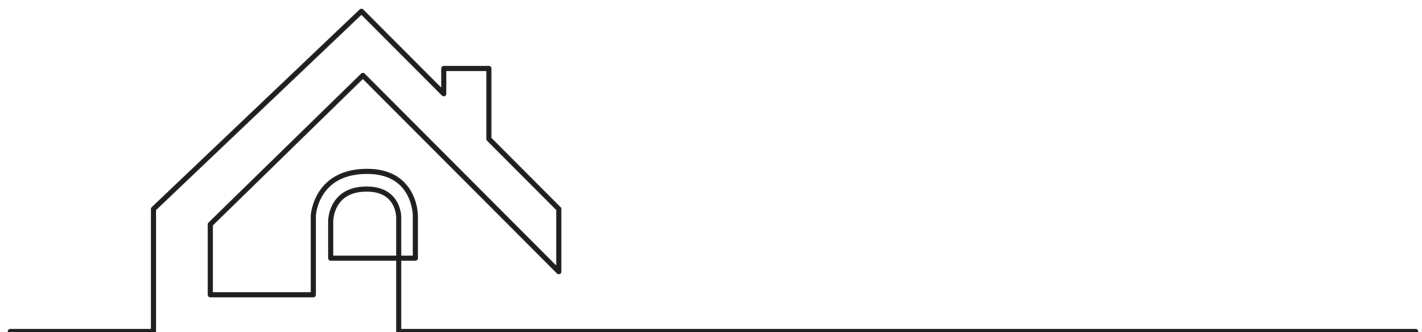
Clear the walkways: Remove excess furniture to make rooms feel larger and safer to walk through.

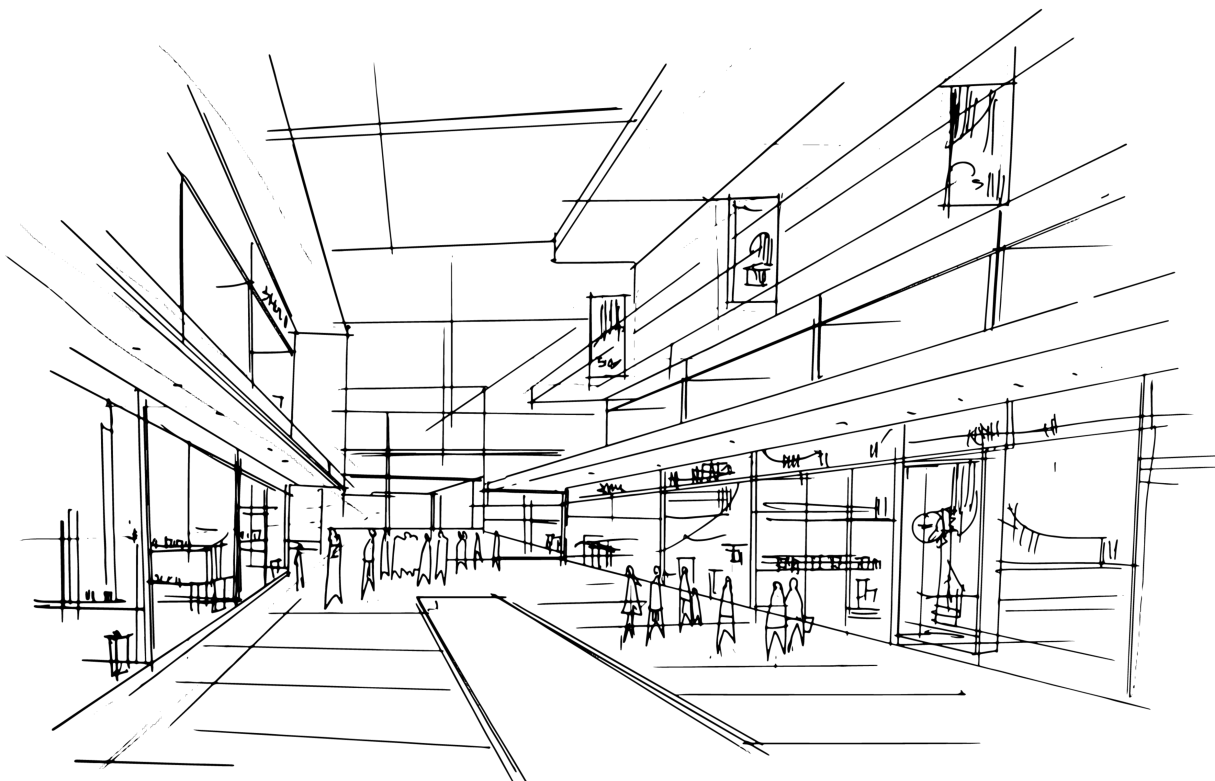
